背景◆

為推動教師專業,彰顯教育對社會發展的重要性,表揚教師對培育下一代的重大貢獻,香港教育學院(教院)以「百分百支持教育」為主題,舉辦「敬師愛生T博士造型設計比賽」暨籌款活動,誠邀全港學生及市民參加。

教院視覺藝術教育榮譽學士課程學生羅小燕以象徵智慧的貓頭鷹為創作主題,設計了外型别緻的吉祥物,製成大型及小型立體塑像。塑像以「T博士」為名,既代表老師(Teacher),也代表對老師的敬意(Tribute)。

活動構思 ◆

- 鼓勵參賽者發揮藝術創意,創作獨一無二的小T博士造型,送贈給老師以表達敬意和謝意。
- 學校可將學生設計之大T博士於校舍展示,美化校園。
- 向學校/公眾推廣藝術教育,藉參與比賽和展覽優秀作品,進一步傳揚「敬師愛生」的訊息。
- 廣邀學校師生、家長、公眾及善長捐款支持教院成立「敬師育才基金」,用作教院學生發展、提供獎助學金及交流資助等,促進學生多元及全人發展,為香港培訓更多知行合一、敏於思考、關懷社會及放眼世界的優秀教師和專業人才。

評審 ◆

- 評審準則:創意及藝術美感
- 初選:每間學校/團體提交參賽作品為最多10個小T博士及3個大T博士,學校可進行校內比賽選拔參賽作品。
- 複選:由香港美術教育協會執行委員及教院專任導師於 每組別的入圍作品中,選出30個小T博士及30個大T博士進入決選。
- 決選:評審團由知名設計師靳埭強博士SBS、麥兜插畫師麥家碧小姐、陳達文博士SBS、湯修齊先生MH、香港美術教育協會執行委員及教院文化與創意藝術學系代表組成,為各組別選出冠、亞、季軍及優異作品。

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To Teachers with Love - Dr T Design Competition cum Fundraising Campaign

Background ◆

To promote teaching as a profession, manifest the importance of education in social development and show appreciation for the teachers who nurture our next generation, The Hong Kong Institute of Education (HKIEd) is organising the "To Teachers with Love – Dr T Design Competition" cum Fundraising Campaign with the theme of "100% Support for Education". Students and people of all ages are welcome to join.


Dr T, an owl symbolic of wisdom, is a mascot designed by Miss Law Siu-yin, a student in the Institute's Bachelor of Education (Honours) (Visual Arts) programme. "Dr T", which connotes "teacher", also has a deeper meaning of "tribute to teacher". The mascot comes in two sizes – big (90 cm in height) and small (12 cm in height).

Concept and Plan ◆

- Participants are encouraged to use their creative talent to design the Dr Small T and convey their love and respect to teachers by presenting it as a small token of thanks.
- Schools are encouraged to display the Dr Big T designed by students as an art object and as a gift of gratitude to the school.
- The competition will promote art appreciation and education, and bring out the "To Teachers with Love" message.
- Schools, teachers, students, parents, the public and philanthropists are invited to support the establishment of the "Appreciate Teachers" Student Development Fund, which will be used for scholarships, bursaries, student exchanges and initiatives for nurturing HKIEd students to become competent teachers and professionals who can integrate theory and practice, and who are intellectually active, socially caring, and globally aware.

- Schools: Kindergarten, Primary School and Secondary School
- Open: Participants of all ages are welcome


- All participants in the first round will receive a certificate of participation issued by HKIEd.
- The champion, first and second runners-up will be awarded trophies, and in the Dr Small T category they will be also awarded book coupons sponsored by the Hong Kong Educational Publishing Company. The honourable mentions and finalists will receive certificates of merit. The outstanding entries will be displayed in an open exhibition, and printed materials may be produced to further promulgate the message of "To Teachers with Love".

Adjudication *

- Judging criteria: creativity and aesthetics
- First round: Each school/organisation may submit up to 10 Dr Small Ts and 3 Dr Big Ts. Schools are encouraged to conduct intra-school competitions for preliminary entry selection.
- Second round: The judging panel, which consists of executive committees of the Hong Kong Society for Education in Art (HKSEA) and HKIEd teaching fellow, will select 30 Dr Small Ts and 30 Dr Big Ts from each category for the final round.
- Final round: The adjudicators, including veteran designer Dr Kan Tai-keung, SBS, illustrator of Mcdull, Ms Alice Mak, Dr Darwin Chen, SBS, Mr Tong Sau-chai, MH, executive committees of the HKSEA and a representative from the HKIEd Department of Cultural and Creative Arts, will select the champion, first and second runners-up and honourable mentions for each category.





Enrolment ◆

- Each school/organisation may submit up to 10 Dr Small Ts and 3 Dr Big Ts.
- For information on donations and/or the enrolment fee, please refer to the enrolment form.
- The completed enrolment form together with a crossed cheque payable to "The Hong Kong Institute of Education" must be sent to the Alumni Affairs and Development Office, HKIEd, 10 Lo Ping Road, Tai Po, on or before 15 November 2013. Please write "To Teachers with Love Dr T Design Competition" on the envelope.
- In December 2013, HKIEd will inform all participating schools and open category participants by mail/email of the arrangements for collecting Dr Ts. Details of the arrangements will also be announced on the official website at www.ied.edu.hk/aado/100supporteducation.

Notes to Participants ◆

- Participants can use different colours and materials (e.g. acrylic) to create their designs on Dr T.
- The design must not disclose the identity of the participants or the related school or organisation, including names and logos.
- Finalists must submit the actual work to HKIEd.
 Non-compliance will result in disqualification.
- Participants can only receive one prize in each category, except for the "My Favourite Dr Small T/ Big T Online Vote Award".
- Participants are responsible for the delivery of the works to and collection of works from HKIEd.
 HKIEd will not be liable for any damage to the works.

Entries Submission <

- The person in charge at the school/organisation and Open category participants must photograph the design and upload the pictures to the official website at www.ied.edu.hk/aado/100supporteducation between 24 February and 7 March 2014.
- Photograph format: 3 photographs (front, side, back) must be submitted for each design in JPG format. The file size of each photo must be between 1MB – 4MB.

Online Vote ◆

 For each category, the 3 submitted designs that gain the highest online votes will be awarded the "My Favourite Dr T Online Vote Award".

Results Announcement *

 HKIEd will announce the competition results on the official website by May 2014. Schools and awardees will be notified by mail.

Terms and Conditions ◆

- All entries must be original designs that are not in breach of any third party's rights (including copyright) and have never been publicly displayed or previously submitted to other competitions. If the entry is found to be in breach of commercial or non-commercial copyright, the participant will be disqualified. HKIEd will not be liable for any copyright infringements arising from entries.
- The adjudicators' decision will be final and not subject to revision.
- Participants agree to authorise HKIEd to use and display the entries for publicity, publication and exhibition purposes. The entries will be returned after the completion of the campaign.
- HKIEd reserves the right to final amendment and the interpretation of any information given in this leaflet.
